Dear Colleagues,

In our First Circular mail, we announced the 18th International Colloquium on Roman Provincial Art which will take place in Belgrade and Viminacium, from **20th** to **25th May 2024**.

Subject of the conference

The main topic of the Colloquium will encompass the significance of the cultural influences, their originality and syncretism in Roman provinces and in which way they traversed the borders which separated Roman provinces one from the other. Different segments of provincial life (historical, military, social, religious etc.) will allow to explore the questions like – were the frontiers of Roman provinces also the cultural ones, since the monuments of material culture (with focus on stone monuments) show stylistic characteristics and analogies on a wider regional territory than Roman administrative units and what different monuments show in reality in that context (referring to stone monuments, sculptures, statuettes, votive reliefs, artefacts of minor arts etc.).

The topics of the Colloquium will be also focused on the:

- penetration and diffusion of cultural influences in the provincial frames or their diffusion and change over the administratively positioned borders of the provinces in the Roman Empire

- changes and differences displayed on the monuments of the Roman provincial art, particularly on the stone monuments but also other monuments as well, through time in the context of their provincial character and particularities

- flexibility of administrative borders viewed in the light of the iconography, motives and symbolism presented on the monuments

- methodology, new analyses and new finds from the recent research or excavations

In addition to these questions, we also welcome presentations which refer to other aspects of Roman provincial art



Types of contributions

-Presentation, duration 20 minutes + 10 minutes discussion

-Short contribution, duration 10 minutes

-Poster contribution, duration 10 minutes

Please submit an abstract of max. 500 words until **December 15th**.

You will be informed about the decision on the acceptance of your proposed lecture until the **1st February.**

1. Participation with lecture/short lecture/poster Submission of the abstract of max. 500 words by December 15th to email <u>crpa18serbia@gmail.com</u> and registration with regular fee by March 31 2024 (you'll be informed about the decision on the acceptance of your proposed lecture by February 1st 2024)

Online registration is necessary for all participants.

2. Participation without lecture Registration by March 31, after which there will be an increased conference fee

Participation in the excursion on the May 25th
2024 (optional)
Registration until March 31 2024

Conference Fees:

Regular fee by March 31 2024: **250 €**

Increased fee from March 31 2024 to April 15: **300 €**

Students and accompanying persons: by March 31 2024: **80 €** and from March 31 to April 15 2024: **130 €**

Bank transfer costs are not included and have to be paid by the participants

<u>Registration fees include</u>: conference materials, event opening cocktail, participation to all lectures, coffee breaks, guided tours in Belgrade (Lapidarium, National Museum of Serbia etc.), visit and session in Viminacium - bus transfer, accommodation and meals in Viminacium (including one night in Viminacium 23rd/24th May).

<u>Registration fees for accompanying persons include</u>: participation in all lectures, coffee breaks, guided tours in Belgrade, transfer without meals and accommodation to and back from Viminacium on 23rd and 24th May.

The excursion on Saturday 25th May is optional and has to be paid separately.

Cancellation fees: Until 31 March 2024: **30 €** After 31 March 2024: **no refund**

The opening ceremony will be held in the University of Belgrade, while all the lectures will take place in the Faculty of Philosophy. Both buildings are one beside the other and situated at the very centre of Belgrade




